Faculty of Economics, Universitas Islam Kadiri, Indonesia and International Relation and Collaboration Centre, Inti International University, Malaysia hereby believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two institutions, achieving a closer relationship by linking their scholars, students and personnel. Both institutions share the strong conviction that mutual understanding can be promoted through the establishment of joint activities. Therefore both institutions agree to enter into this Memorandum of Agreement.

Pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries, as well as the procedures and policy of the Government of Indonesia and the Kingdom of Malaysia concerning academic and educational cooperation, the parties have agreed to cooperate in the field of:

1. Exchange of researchers or staff

2. Coordination of joint research projects in mutual cooperation

3. Organization of joint academic activities such as academic conference, cooperative lectures, special short training courses, seminars, and symposia

 Exchange of publications and instructional materials on disaster mitigation and other relevant topics

This memorandum of agreement becomes effective on the date of signature. It is valid for five years with understanding that it can be terminated by either party with one months notice, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon. Revisions or modifications may be proposed at any time, effective from the date of written agreement signed by both parties.
